

2018 Toowoomba & Lockyer Valley Club Championship Rules

Dates

Round 1 – 18th February - (*Masters Feature - \$500 Cash Draw all classes entries*)

Round 2 – 18th March – (TAGR – Light /Heavy Feature - \$500 Cash Draw all classes entries)

Round 3 – 20th May – (ALM DUNLOP – Challenge & Final Round \$1000 Draw entrants for 3 rounds)

Round 4 – 15th June – (Winter Carnival Rnd 1)

Round 5 – 22nd July – (Winter Carnival Rnd 2)

Round 6 – $18/19^{th}$ August – (Winter Carnival Rnd 3 – 19^{th}) – (RKA F100 –King of the North Rnd1)

Round 7 – 16th September – (Gold Cup Carnival Flowers)

Race Day October 21st - Club Day (not a round of the club Championship – F100 will be contested)

Round 8 – 17/18th November (Double Direct) – (RKA F100 Rnd 2)

(Above dates are subject to change) (*** Proposed National Championship for October 21st)

Points will be awarded for each round as follows -

The official meeting results will be used to determine the points awarded to **Eligible T&LV Kart Club Members.**

1st place Receiving 40 points plus 0.5% for every eligible driver in the race

2nd place Receiving 38 points plus 0.5% for every eligible driver in the race

3rd place Receiving 37 points plus 0.5% for every eligible driver in the race & so on down to last place.

Example – 4 T&LV members in the class.

First receives 40 points plus 2% = 40.80

Second receives 38 points plus 2% = 38.76

Third receives 37 points plus 2% = 37.74

Fourth receives 36 points plus 2% = 36.72

- ➤ If a competitor is classified as a DSQ in the final race of the race day, zero points will be awarded for that meeting.
- Of these 8 rounds, only the 7 highest scoring will be counted.
 If a driver has received zero points for a round due to a DSQ or by not attending, at least one of these rounds must be counted.

Eligibility for Club Champions Status

- ➤ Each driver must be a full family or single financial member of the Toowoomba & Lockyer Valley Kart Club 2018. They must compete in a minimum of 5 of the 8 championship rounds specified to accumulate points for the 2018 Championship.
- ➤ Points will accrue from the date their club membership is paid.
- ➤ A competitor is only eligible to be included in the club championship points if they attend a minimum of <u>one</u> of the three club organised working bees in 2018
- > The dates for these working bees will be placed on the T&LV website & Facebook page. Details of each working bee will be advised by email/Facebook prior to their respective dates once organised.
- Either parent can qualify for their dependant/s if the competitors are a cadet or junior driver.

Trophies

- ➤ Club Championship Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 placegetters in all classes that have at least 3 drivers meeting the minimum requirements for club championship points.
- If less than 3 entries in the class, trophies will only be presented to the winner and runner up (if eligible)
- Club Champion status will be awarded to the Cadet 9 A (Comer) & B (Vortex), Cadet 12, Junior & Senior drivers with the highest accumulated points. There must be at least 4 drivers in the class to be considered for Club Champion Status.
- If there is a tie at the end of the scheduled rounds, the winner is the competitor who completed the most championship rounds. If still tied, the winner is the competitor who has the most round wins over the season. If still tied, who placed higher at the first round & so on until a winner can be declared.

Disputes

The Club Executive will consider all issues, disputes or clarifications raised via the Club Secretary, without prejudice.

The Club Executives will be the judge of any dispute relating to the interpretation of the rules or the points awarded & their decision will be final.

Cash Award

A substantial cash award will be awarded by way of a random draw at the
presentation awards day of all eligible club members who have participated as an
entrant in at least 5 rounds of the 2018 club championship
