



COME AND TRY POLICY

PURPOSE

Come and try days are run under strict controls to ensure your safety and as an introduction to the sport of Karting.

WHEN

Toowoomba Kart Club advertises dates for racing and other events, therefore bookings for “**Come and Try**” are arranged on an as required basis , and available to club members and guests on request.

COSTS

Currently there is a small fee of \$10.00 per driver to Come and Try Go Karting. If you then join the club, you will receive a \$10.00 discount on your club membership.

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING

Drivers need to have appropriate protective clothing (including enclosed footwear), gloves and a properly fitted helmet. The club has these items available for use. You may prefer to use your own if you have one. We also have a range of karts that are available and the seat size may be a restriction for some.

WHAT RULES YOU NEED TO KNOW

1. Participants will be under the control and guidance at all times..
2. The track will be cleared and only the “Come and Try” driver/s will be allowed on the track for an approximate 10 minute session..
3. Drivers must wear appropriate protective clothing, properly fitted helmets, gloves and appropriate footwear.
4. Drivers must read / have explained the wording of the Indemnity on the form provided, and then acknowledging the terms and conditions, must sign the document.
5. All drivers must complete and sign required paperwork before being allowed onto the track.
6. If a driver is less than 18 years of age, the driver and guardian must sign both the Come and Try Forms and Waiver Form
