MINIMUM ENTRIES : Discretion of Organisers - Classes may be combined at the discretion of the organisers	
FORMAT OF RACING – 4 Events of Racing plus Qualifying - All points count – 0 Points Scoring System	
Practice/ Qualifying/ Format.	3 Lap Warm up continuing into (1) Qualifying session of 5 minutes Heat 1 & 2 grids established from qualifying times Heat 3 Grid from established results and accumulated points from Heats 1 & 2 Heat 4 (Final Race) grid from established results & accumulated points from Heats 1 & 2 & 3
Results	All points count to determine the event final result. All drivers classified according to the number of completed laps in all races
Heat 1,2,3	All Classes 8 Laps – Heat 4 (Final Race) 10 Laps
Assistance	Whenever a Kart is on the track after the start signal is given, it is forbidden to receive any assistance, other than to remove the kart to a place of safety.
Fuel	PULP and E10 PULP are the only commercially available fuels permitted to be used at this Meeting. Fuel Testing will take place

All Pit Crew must remain behind a protective barrier at all time – no coaching is permitted during a race.	
Karts can be retrieved via Grid gate.	
Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility unless leashed.	
No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at or in the Circuit.	
All footwear when on the IN and or OUT grids is to be enclosed footwear – eg: no thongs /scuffs on any grid
